What is excellence in education?

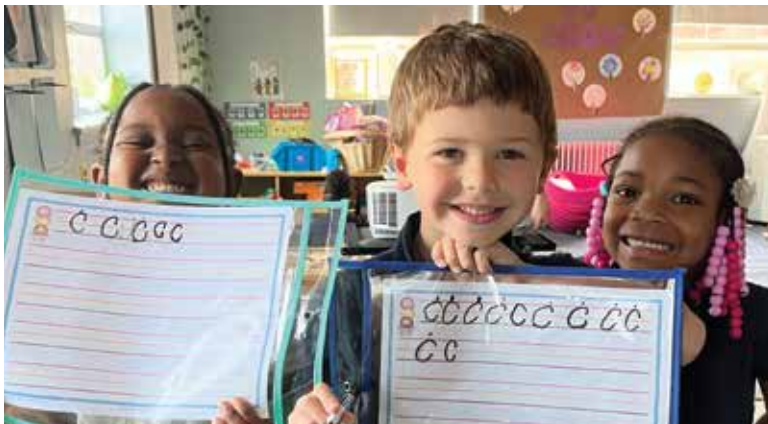

Logos is a place where his mom, Astrid, can openly collaborate with staff and faculty to best meet Johnxiell’s academic, emotional, social, and spiritual needs.

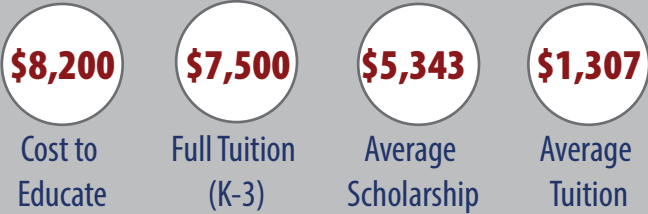
A Different Type of School

In 2016, our founders were moved by faith to start a school where every student could receive an excellent education, regardless of their family’s income. Opening our doors with just preschool, we now have 50 students, pre-k through third grade. Without the aid of government funding, generous donors give scholarships to make it possible for students who normally would not be able to afford tuition to attend at just a fraction of the cost. Everybody pays something to attend, and the results speak for themselves. Students from across the economic and cultural spectrum are succeeding academically and spiritually at Logos Academy Harrisburg.

allowing us to serve up to **80 students.**

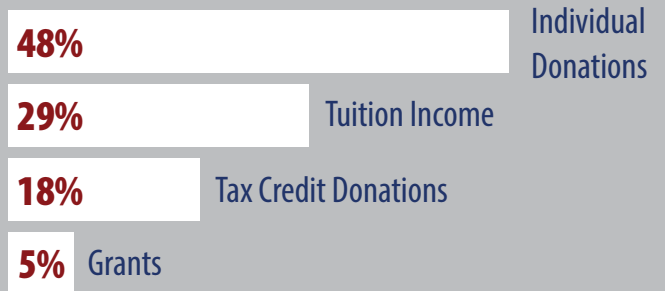

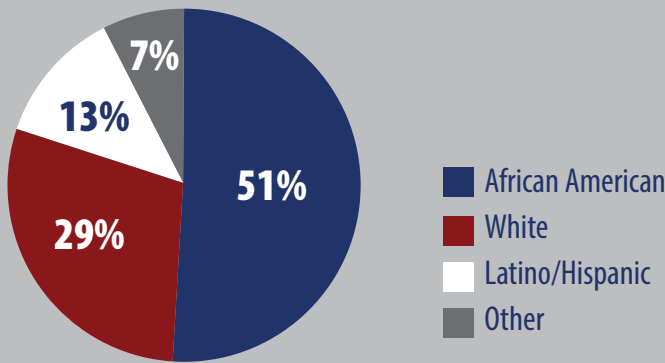
42% indicate no religious affiliation

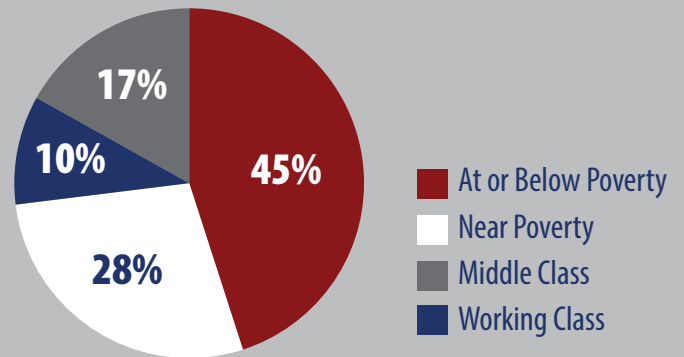
Fiscal Year 2022 School Income
