Meet Grayson

"Grayson is a different kid!" proclaims his mom, Tia, and grandmom, Monica. "He's come out of his shell." When Grayson

started kindergarten at Logos Academy Harrisburg, his mom wondered whether he had a learning delay or if he was struggling with challenges related to anxiety and the ramifications of COVID.

Thanks to a strong parent partnership, invested teachers, and a support specialist, Grayson's come a long way since his early days at Logos Academy. He's now a model third-grade student and is excelling academically, exceeding not just his growth goal but even his stretch goal.

But it's not just about academics at Logos Academy Harrisburg; it's also about human formation. Grayson has grown socially and emotionally, and he is exceptionally kind. His mom says, "He's able to express himself so well and can talk about his emotions." Tia appreciates the small class sizes, where teachers can address individual student needs to better shape learning and growth. Tia also likes the "faith part" of Logos Academy Harrisburg, and notes that she's seen growth here as well. She says Grayson has a sincere and deep concern to please God. He is a living example of the impact of a true education, which, according to Martin Luther King, Jr., is one of intellect and character.

A Different Type of School

Recognizing a need for education options in Harrisburg, especially for the under-resourced communities of the city, the New City School project was launched, largely driven by the pastor and members of Second City Church. In 2016 after several years of ground work, we opened our doors with a preschool of just nine students. We now have almost 70 students, pre-K through fourth grade. Without the aid of government funding, generous donors give scholarships to make it possible for students who normally would not be able to afford tuition to attend at just a fraction of the cost. Everybody pays something to attend, and the results speak for themselves. Students from across the economic and cultural spectrum are succeeding academically and spiritually at Logos Academy Harrisburg.




